## Sixteen UN and international organisations working in humanitarian relief and sustainable development are relaunching the Sustainable Impact Hub in Davos during the World Economic Forum 2019 Annual Meeting.

The Hub is a dedicated partnership venue where World Economic Forum participants and journalists are invited to drop in to discuss, learn about and advance partnerships with organizations working together under the theme Leave no one behind: Partnering for impact. Visitors can also explore interactive exhibitions and virtual reality experiences, informative videos, and live broadcast discussions on the most pressing issues for collaboration.



Journalists are invited to arrange bilateral interviews with collaborating partners inside the Sustainable Impact Hub and to attend the Networking Reception in the Hub from 5.45 p.m. to 7.30 p.m. on Thursday 24 January.

*The Davos Sustainable Impact Hub is located some 600 metres from the Congress Centre at Promenade 72, Davos Platz. It will be open from 22 to 26 January from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.*

The Sustainable Impact Hub partnering organisations have come together with a shared mission and commitment to demonstrate how collaboration can help meet the Sustainable Development Goals for everyone and to ensure no one is left behind. The World Economic Forum 2019 Annual Meeting theme: Globalization 4.0: Shaping a Global Architecture in the Age of the Fourth Industrial Revolution is an opportunity to incorporate cross sector partnerships as a fundamental part of the new “Global Architecture”. The need is greater than ever to work together to address persisting inequalities and make a positive impact on the lives of vulnerable people most at risk from development deficits, natural disasters and conflict.
