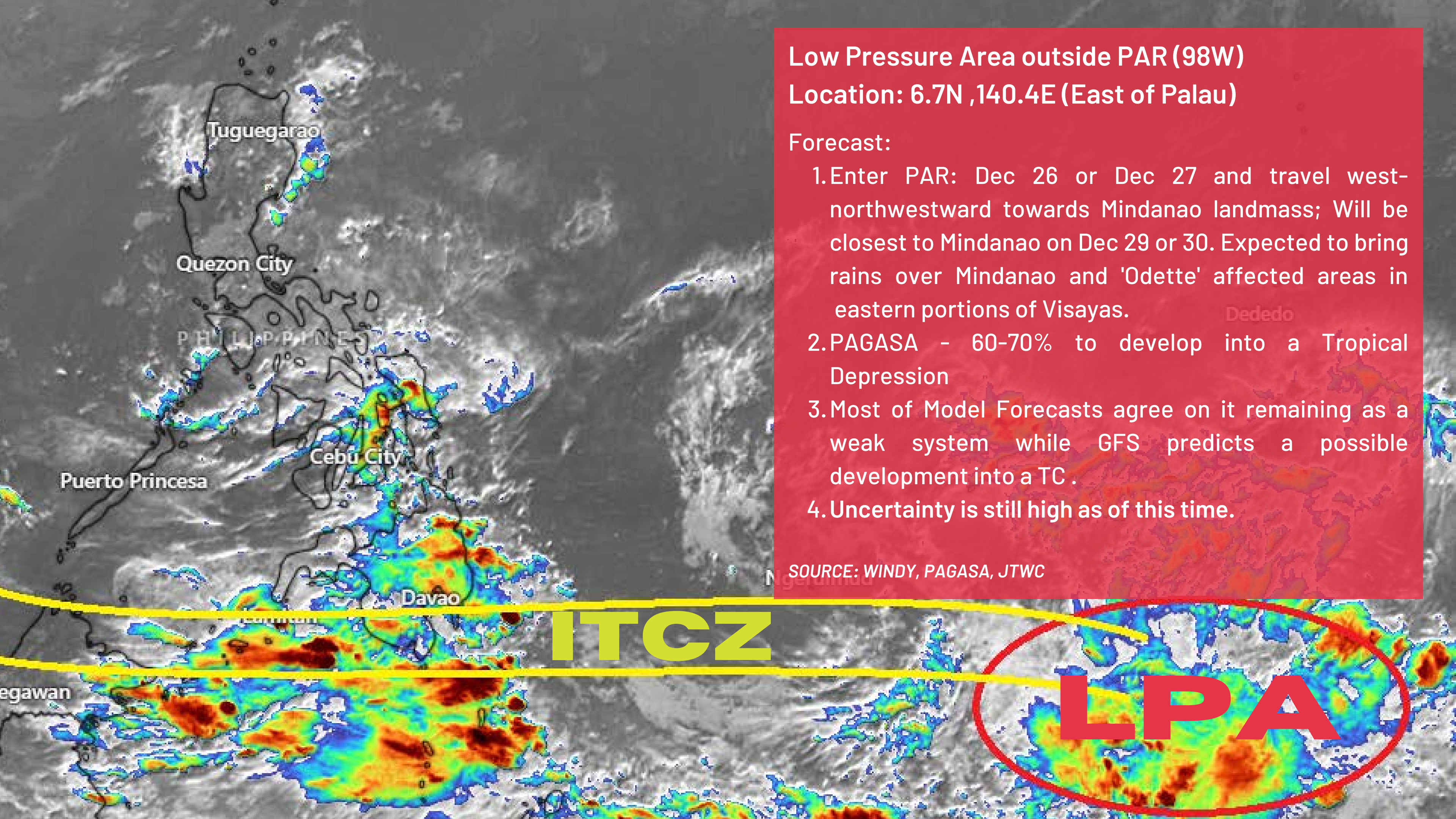

Low Pressure Area outside PAR (98W)

Location: 6.7N ,140.4E (East of Palau)

Forecast:

1. Enter PAR: Dec 26 or Dec 27 and travel west-northwestward towards Mindanao landmass; Will be closest to Mindanao on Dec 29 or 30. Expected to bring rains over Mindanao and 'Odette' affected areas in eastern portions of Visayas.
2. PAGASA - 60-70% to develop into a Tropical Depression
3. Most of Model Forecasts agree on it remaining as a weak system while GFS predicts a possible development into a TC.
4. Uncertainty is still high as of this time.

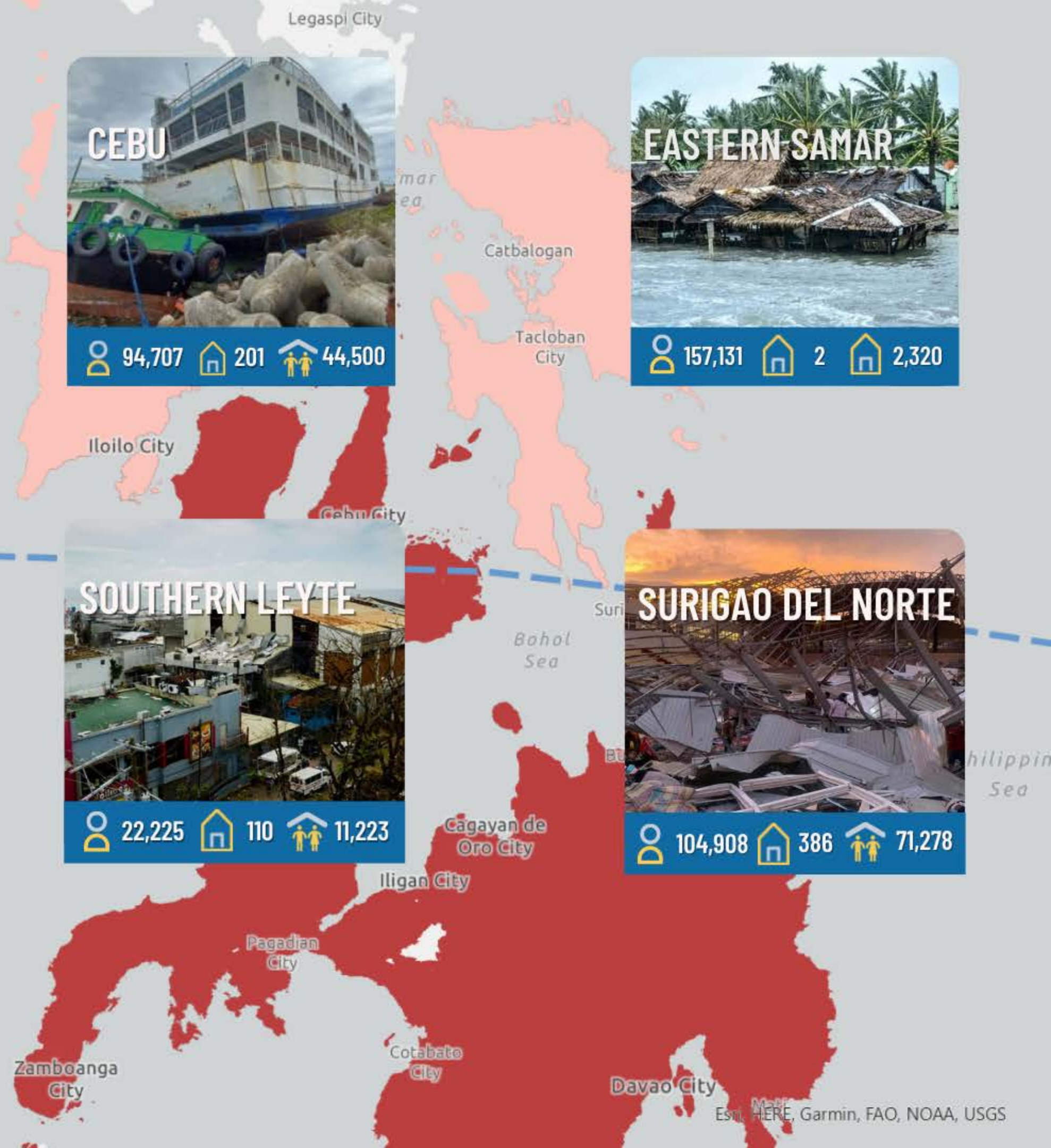

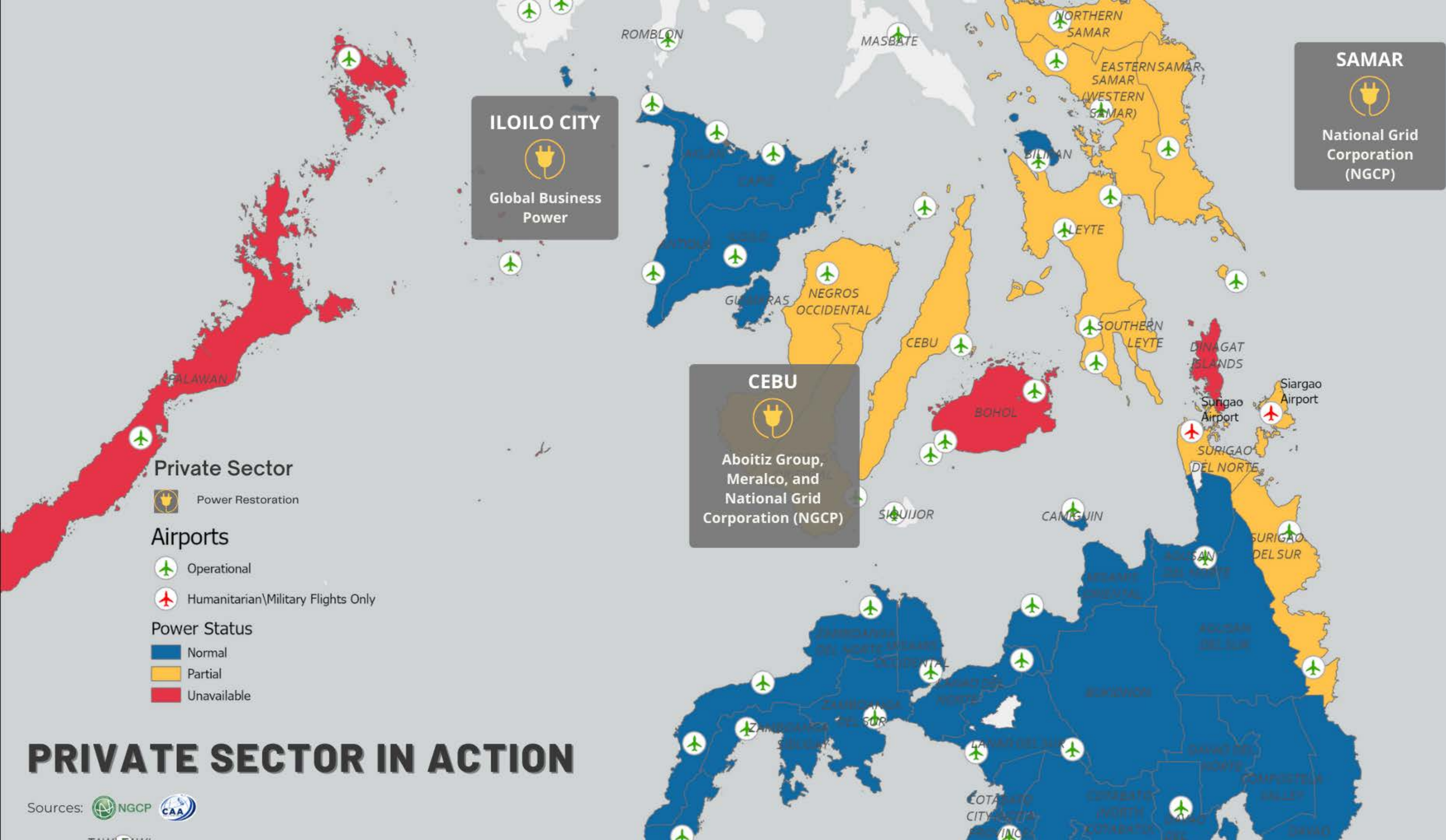

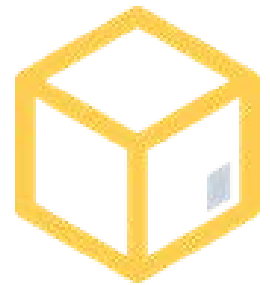
